# WELCOME!

## REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Registration forms are processed on a first come, first served basis. Forms may be submitted by mail or in person at any time. A separate registration form is required for each child.

- Send a completed registration form and non-refundable \$50 deposit for **each** child to St. Elizabeth School. The deposit is applied to the total fees.
- Total balance due date is June 12<sup>th</sup>.
- St. Elizabeth's may cancel a program due to low enrollment. Parents will be notified in a timely manner if such a decision is made and a refund will be granted. Programs will not be prorated for partial attendance.



## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- All campers in 9 am - 12 pm programs should bring a snack and drink every day. Campers in full day programs should bring a brown bag lunch, snack, and drink each day.
- All campers must be picked up no later than 5 minutes after the end of their program. A late fee of \$20 will be assessed for late pick up.

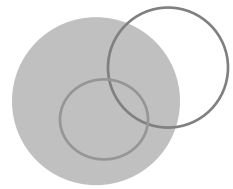

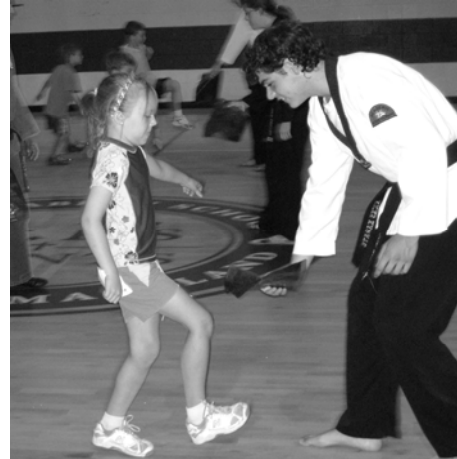

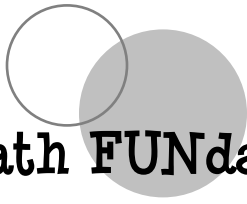
